The second book in Kyra Lennon's Game On series, Blindsided steps away from the raw passion that was Leah and Radleigh, as Westberg Warriors star Jesse Shaw enjoys a well earned vacation in England. Even though Blindsided has a very different tone from Game On - appealing more to the YA crowd, and set in a different location - it still offers everything we know and love from the first in the series.
