Blood Brothers has an interesting premise with the two leads being assassins. The action starts from the first page of the book and keep going until the end. Even though the book is 300+ pages you'll end up reading it sooner because of the fast-pace and your curiosity to find out what happens next when you are done with a page. That's something I like about DC Moore, his ability to keep the readers interested even with the amount of pages he wrote for this story. I've experienced myself feeling bored with books that only span a 100 pages and I find myself skipping the content and jumping to the dialogues to see what's happening. That wasn't the case with Blood Brothers and I was glad. I noticed the book already getting a lot of good reviews so, my expectations were high. As a reader of several of Dean C. Moore's works, I know him to be one of the finest sci-fi/fantasy writers in the world. Therefore, I had high expectations for Blood Brothers: Escape to Creeporia and it did not disappoint.

I would have liked the story to start with more punch, but once it gets going the action does not relent and I was swept away by the author's imagination. The mish-mash of genres with robots, dragons, sorceresses and assassins in a futuristic setting may seem strange to some, but this is an approach the Japanese have been using for decades and fans of anime will feel right at home (but the book retains an American feel.) I particularly love the way anything is possible in Moore's strange world, and you can never be sure what he is gonna throw at you next. As such, every turn of the page is an intriguing prospect.

The dynamics between the Blood Brothers and their friends/family are funny and riveting. It is the author's sense of humour (and consistent internal logic) that helps justify the absurdity on display. Moore has two intentions with this book: to preach, and to have fun. And he succeeds on both levels.

Moore effortlessly switches from deep and complex narrative to delightfully crude humour and some of the one-liners will literally stop you in your tracks. Great word economy and alchemy are hallmarks of Moore's work, as are fantastic dialogue and characterisation. Basically, this book ticks all of the boxes.

Technically flawless, commercial and high-level, I found this to be a stimulating read; one which will excite the average guy on the street as much as the intellectual. One thing is for sure - if you read one of Dean C. Moore's works, it will leave you wanting to read more. This is excellent stuff.

If you are like me, it is now almost a reflex action to 'click away' at the mention of a new e-book author and return only when they have built a reputation for solid, good writing. So often are we disappointed when buying books from new authors and find the author has rushed to publication before the work is ready. In consequence all new authors are being subliminally labelled "Amateur!" As a further consequence, we are missing out on the works of those 'good' new authors, who produce and publish works of a 'Professional' standard.

Let me shout and ring out from the Bells of Bow that Dean C. Moore firmly belongs in the category of 'Professional author,' producing works to a high ethical standard.

Dean is more than writer. He's also a philosopher and social critic of our times, brining his views and observations of our new Global order to his writing.

Blood Brothers is a futuristic novel that is written in real time. It follows the adventures of twin brothers separated from each other at birth, but whose ambitions and desires are so similar they become top assassins in the new Global Order. There tastes in women are such that they both marry sorceresses.

The time inevitably comes when a person is beyond usefulness. For an assassin there is only one way to retire- it is sudden and final. The adventures begin as they seek to escape the fate determined for them through their skills, wits, cunning and wiles assisted by the dark powers of their wives.

This is a riveting read, but don't let your attention wander for a second as you'll miss something important. This is a book that I found to be smarter, more creative and devious than similar fiction; devious in the sense that there is a message for us all to consider in our real world of today. I am looking forward to the next book.

When do assassins become too dangerous for their employers? The answer in this case is when they develop latent super powers. This is the premise of Dean. C. Moore's impressive novel and at the emotional heart of the story are Jared and Clay (the assassins in question and brothers separated from birth) who must take on a ruthless elite who now want them dead. At this level of the narrative, *Blood Brothers* is something of an action thriller with an incredibly high body count with knives, bullets and even shurikens flying in all directions.
