Book 2 in the A Fleurs d'amour Novella series, this is a new to me author, and I thought she did a great job of making this book work as a standalone. I didn't feel like I was missing out by not having read book 1, though it's definitely on my TBR now as I've already 1-clicked it. ?

The story really hooked me right from the start with that prologue--plus enemies to lovers and boss-employee relationships are two of my favorite tropes--but it was Cassidy who really made the book: she is simply a fabulous character, and I loved her snarky attitude. She had me laughing time and time again with all her antics, and the dialogue between Cassidy and the other characters had me rolling.
