What struck me as authentic and maybe one of the best advertising warnings that I've seen with a book was on the book's Amazon page was the heading: Loosely Based On True Events. What I liked about the book was that unlike most urban fiction it was free of many grammatical errors, but filled with sex, violence, betrayal, and drama.
