Cheryl McIntyre is one of those versatile authors that has the ability to make the reader **cry big fat ugly tears, experience unimaginable heartbreak, pace around in frustration - and most importantly, she has the ability to make you fall in love.** And that's exactly what I did with this book, I fell head over heels in love minutes into the story. Always Forever focuses on the lives of Misty and Kellin. They first meet each other as children and then spend the next several years weaving in and out of each other's existence. Each time they cross paths, they get that one step closer to almost making their feeling for each other a reality - however fate intervenes and it slips from their grasp everytime. I'm a firm believer in love and I believe that everything happens for a reason, that we have to make the most of each opportunity as its presented to us. For Misty and Kellin, their last attempt at turning their friendship into something more ends in catastrophic results. The two drift farther apart, and the years pass again.

Set to enter her last year of college in Ohio, Misty has worked hard the past 3 years to let go of Kellin and the pain he caused her. Finally moving on with a great guy, she finds herself in love with Luke. A handsome, successful boy a few years older than her - he's ready to settle down and move on with the next phase of his life. And he makes that quite clear when he proposes to Misty after just a 10 month relationship. Now, you're probably thinking - what's the problem?! He's rich, successful, hot - and he wants to marry her! All that is perfect on the surface, but Misty's **heart and head are singing two different tunes.** Sensing her hesitation, Luke suggests that Misty spend the summer "*sowing her wild oats.*" To return to him before the school year begins again, ready to start their life again. Misty knows exactly where she will go. To Chicago. To find Kellin..

Kellin Patel has learned to **live with regret.** He made a colossal mistake 3 years ago and it cost him an amazing girl he was halfway in love with. Flitting from one relationship to the next since then has diminished his self worth, left him wondering if he would ever find the love and romance he is desperately craving. Burned from his latest relationship failure after having just found out his girlfriend cheated on him, he has about given up hope. Deep down he has been punishing himself for years over hurting Misty and breaking her heart. When she suddenly pops up out of the blue in front of him, not only is he shocked to see her, but his heart leaps at the chance to redeem himself and win back the girl he's always loved. When Misty and her best friend Sadie agree to accompany him on camping trip - it's like nothing could go wrong. It seems they are both set to get what they want, Misty - a chance at answers. Kellin a chance to **win her heart once and for all.**

I loved the romance of this book. The way the two **intertwined throughout each other's lives appealed to me,** even though they never had the best outcomes. When they finally reunite and embark on their camping trip, its like all the stars aligned. Unfortunately, they are both so stubborn - they don't realize that what they want is staring them in the face, quite literally in those small tents. I wanted to grab the two of them and smash them together, screaming at them to get their heads out of the sand.

This story is true love in its finest form. When Kellin learns of Misty's pending engagement, I actually could hear his heart crack. The more they are together, the more they both can't deny that the feelings are still very real between them. The countdown to the end of the summer is maddening, with us left wondering what Misty's choice will be. Can she trust her heart to Kellin again? Or is her future better set with Luke?

But this is a Cheryl McIntyre book so we know that we will see the heartache again...and we do. Just when I thought it was all set to work out - **a huge bomb is dropped.** One I didn't see coming...
One that shatters the world of all parties involved and leaves us wondering how they can ever find their happy ending.

If you love a angsty romantic read, this is a book for you. If you've followed the series, you'll be happy to see the reappearance of some of the other characters, however this book can be read as a stand alone. I recommend reading the entire series as its just that damn good.

As for Misty and Kellin - **what will their Always Forever be?** Eternal heartbreak? The love of a lifetime? Pick up a copy and let them tell you their story.
