We see that Janelle is extremely smart, a beautiful girl but like many of us, she has her own personal insecurities that she has had to deal with throughout her life. She comes from a well to do home and all she wants is to make her extremely successful father proud of her endeavors. Luke, on the other hand, seems to fit every stereotype of a 'bad boy' He is on trial for murder, he has the prerequisite gold grill, tattoos, and has the audacity to be sexy to boot. The thing is all of these things don't even scratch the surface of who he is as a man. We are introduced to Luke aka Outlaw's brothers, Kane, Tank, Yolo, and Cree. They each equally contribute to the story line and we are given glimpses of how tight they are and we even get to see how they handle situations when they arise. Here is the conundrum though while the outside world may look at these "THUGS" and automatically think that they are a menace to society, the exact opposite is the truth. Each of them is intelligent and college-educated.
