I enjoyed being back in Clear Creek, Kansas with another wonderful addition to the Grooms With Honor series. Each of these books will read as a stand-alone and even better when you read each of them, preferably in order. The Reagan family will become near and dear to your heart. This addition will be the story of Cullen Reagan and Rose Leander.

The phrase, 'no good deed goes unpunished,' quickly becomes a reality for Cullen Reagan. Helping German immigrant, Richard Kandt, by writing a letter to a mail-order bride agency and then by writing letters to his intended bride will backfire on him. Richard needs a strong woman to help on his ranch, and when the delicate and injured Rose Leander gets off the train, Richard will back out.

Rose Leander needs to have a quieter life, one not living on the go, on trains, and never stopping. Being part of the Flying Leander family had its good and bad sides. But after a train accident where she was injured, she cannot perform and has decided to become a mail-order bride and start a family. She was moved by the beautiful letters and description of Clear Creek, Kansas and will accept the offer of marriage by Richard Kandt.

The story is a journey and new beginnings. While Cullen does not ever see himself marrying, he is placed in a sticky situation. With Richard backing out of the offer of marriage, Cullen's adopted parents, Patrick and Kaitlyn Reagan are pushing him to step forward.

"I think we'd have a lot in common, Mr. Reagan. I accept your marriage proposal."

The Reagans will allow Rose to stay with them and will also have family dinners. During the dinners, it will come to light about Rose's family and the circus. That will be another point of contention with Cullen, the clothing she wore for performances and the fear that she will grow restless and leave. There are times he feels she is manipulating him and that doesn't set well.

"His life was being taken over by a circus ringleader."

Cullen has bitterness about his mother's life in a brothel, and how he was kicked to the streets when she died.

Meeting Charlie Moore and introducing Rose to him is healing across the board for the three of them. Letting Charlie tell him more about Cullen's mother changes some of his opinions, but then Rose is willing to add Charlie to the family.

Will the truth about his mother that he has since learned from his father heal the heartache and bitterness he feels? Cullen will learn more about his past and how he really was loved. It also gives him closure and offers him a chance with his biological father. Rose is the balm that he has needed in his life, and she has the personality and stamina to make things happen.

“Who knew writing letters for another would bring the love of his life to town?”

The story has a great cast of characters and many people from previous stories. It deals with regrets, misunderstandings, preconceived notions, unique individuals, new beginnings, and family. The Grooms With Honor series is a great way to see that things sometimes are worse in our imagination than what was the truth. For a six-year-old child, those memories will be changed as an adult, once the history and truth are revealed. The story is a clean historical western romance.
