This is a relationship story, or so says the book blurb. However, this is really just a series of sex scenes strung together with a loose concept. There are two instances in which the author introduces conflict. In one instance it is cleared up in roughly one paragraph. In the other it is drawn out over a "chapter" and then immediately fixed (with sex). Also, the author lazily relies upon her initial set up in the meat locker as a relationship crutch for this couple. To be perfectly honest, I'm wondering if she just wanted to cut and paste some typing to elongate the book. There's a continuity issue in which Sela describes a memorable sex scene and then when Yosi is speaking he doesn't remember that particular sex scene. Ultimately, I'm telling you that this book has little to no plot.

If you're interested in one steamy sex scene after another to the point where you're not sure you care about either character, then this is the book for you. I had issues with it. I like a little plot.

Also, some world building would be nice. I read her first story in the shifter series hoping that would clear up some of my confusion, nope just more questions were created. For instance, why are there so many were creatures in the world? Why are the were creatures so fixated on reproduction if there are so very many of them? Is it just to introduce more sex scenes? Also, if you're going to put such a major emphasis on finding one's mate, you should probably define what that means to a were (there are only hints of this in "He Ain't Lion"). Furthermore, I shouldn't need to read the previous 18 "novels" in a world to figure all of this out, maybe a few hints would be nice in each story. Also, it is implied that yetis aren't weres but we're never given any real background on what makes them different.

Lastly, I feel like God came up too much in this book. It was really weird.
