It's very *slick* looking. There is next to no substance, though, as the plot of the book is a watered-down Dora episode, and Dora isn't exactly what I'd call a potent mix to begin with. Plus, there's the price of it. WAY too high for what you get. The price is for the Dora name and that's it as far as I can tell. I've never been a fan of paying for labels, and I am NOT starting now. Maybe I'll feel different after reading 20 or so (hey, I do have a 4-year-old, and I did pay for the damned thing, so I'm not exactly going to delete it), but I doubt it.
