Detective Voort is in a rush against time to try to find the serial killer. It is very unusual for a woman to be a serial killer and very little clues as to who she might be or why she might be murdering.

The only thing that really makes this book stand out from inferior crime novels and the only reason I gave this three stars, was the portrayal of Nora's back story and the dissection of her motives for carrying out the murders. This, I found well written and held my interest well. Other things, not so much.
