Ok so finally we get back to the Donovan saber-toothed tiger family who have mysteriously had nothing happen to them for several books.

In this book there is the unlikely trio of a tiger, fairy, and vampire together.

Sasha Donovan is a saber-toothed tiger shifter who while selflessly help other fleeing shifters relocate. While on a run to help a family of shifter bares move Sasha a blue light out of the corner of his eye and goes to investigate. That blue light turns out to be none other than his mate.

Imogen Milford is a prince of the fae and second in line for the throne with an intense hatred for vampires after they killed his parents.

Sasha does not hesitate to rescue Imogen when he finds the powerful fairy bruised and battered after a narrow escape from a bunch of vampire.

Sasha brings Imogen to a vampire coven and quickly realises his mistake when several of the vampires start eyeing Imogen like he is tonight's dinner, and at the same time finds his second mate.

Aaron Loman is a vampire who recently parted from his longtime partner. And is crouched when he finds that one of his mates is afraid of him.

Sasha, Imogen and Aaron end up at Sasha's brother Avery's home with his mates and their three adopted baby lion shifter daughters.

Ok I'm going to stop there because that is just the set up for the rest of the book, however I will say that throughout the entire book I feel sorry for Aaron because he gets the short end of the stick because of Imogen's fear of vampires. I think I personally would have walked away.

Anyway I did not enjoy this book as much as I did the others in this series and I can not say why. 2 and a half stars for effort.

The combination of different types of paranormals is half the fun of this series. At least one is a saber-tooth tiger (or other big cat), but as for the other two, that is always a nice surprise. In this volume Sasha, a saber-tooth tiger shifter, truly has his hands full with a fae prince who hates vampires and a vampire who wants nothing more than to find and love his mates. How much more difficult can it get?

Sasha is always rescuing someone and one of the nicest guys around. It was particularly hard for him to be torn between two men, one of whom hated the other. Imogen, once I found out why he hates vampires, was easier to understand, and he does redeem himself and show wonderful growth by the end of the book. Aaron, the vampire whose long-term friend/partner just left him because he found his own mate, fears to be rejected again. What a mess! Add some attacking zombie-vampires and the confusion and tension is just right.

If you like unusual shifter and paranormal pairings, are interested in following an emotional confrontation between two mates who know they'll have to share the rest of their lives together, and want some hot sex on top, you may enjoy this light read.
