I received an ARC of Fall Dirty in exchange for a honest review.

While I've only read one novella in this boxed set, it iwas worth the .99! I've read several of Zoe York's novels and I must say that I really, really enjoyed Fall Dirty!!! It has a hot, sexy SEAL, Hunter, who is hell bent on pleasing "his woman", Serena. Hunter likes sex, actually loves it and thinks everything is great between himself and Serena. One night, while using Serena's computer, he stumbles across her "searches". He realizes that Serena likes sex a little "kinky", but is almost afraid to ask her how kinky she likes it. He thinks some kink may be okay, but he has limits.

While Serena truly believes she's found "the one" in Hunter, she secretly wonders if he'd like her "secret", kinky side. I haven't read all the books in this anthology yet so this review is for Bring The Heat which was given to me by Kimberley Troutte in exchange for an honest review. I love the SEAL EXtreme Team series so I jumped at the chance to get this ARC.

This starts with Jackson, Rebecca, and some others moving top secret tanks in a 3 truck convoy when it's hijacked by ex-military men. Jackson and the other men are shot but Rebecca was kept alive because the group needed her to drive through check points. Things get more tense when another SEAL, Tavon, gets attacked in his home, his wife is kidnapped and put in one of the trucks. Tavon calls his SEAL team for help rescuing her.

I liked the plot and found it to be a very exciting escape that I didn't want to end. Kimberly Troutte's well written and polished style brings this story to life. The easy way in which she draws readers into her world creates a fantastic backdrop for her wonderful story. The story itself is intricately crafted, giving readers the full experience. It's fast paced with many twists and turns along the way.

So far I've only read two of the books in this boxed set but just these two books alone are worth the cost of the set.

SEAL's Deception is one of the best romantic suspense stories I've read by Elle James and I've read a lot of her books.

Ben "Big Bird" Sjodin is a member of SEAL Team 10 and he, along with 2 other members of his team, is assigned to assist a CIA agent with a special project. Ben doesn't know who his contact even is. When a sexy woman he's dancing with says the code word he's intrigued.

Thus begins a great suspenseful adventure with a romance that neither Ben nor Yasmin sees coming.

This story had all of the things I look for in a romantic suspense story. A handsome, sexy hero, a badass, sexy heroine, an interesting plot and writing that kept me on the edge of my seat until the end. There is also plenty of sexy time and a scene that made me laugh out loud to the extent that my husband made me read it to him so he could know what I found so funny.

While this story isn't a real long one Elle James still does a good job with character development. I got a sense of who Yasmin was and why this job was so important to her. I've read about Ben in previous Take No Prisoners stories and I'm so happy that he's finally gotten one of his own.

Even though this is book number 8 in the Take No Prisoners series it is also a standalone with no cliffhanger.

Baby It's You by Delilah Devlin

This may not be a long story but it hit all the right buttons for me. Ms. Devlin did an excellent job of giving us enough background to make me connect with the characters. Melanie has never forgotten her brief encounter with Carter but she doesn't know that it's also been the same for him.

Carter believes that his father hates him so he left home years ago and became a SEAL. After he is injured he finally comes back to the ranch to face the loose ends he left behind. As much as he doesn't want to, he knows that he needs to see his dying father. He also needs to make things right with Melanie.

The heat between Melanie and Carter is scorching but I also felt so sad for both characters. I always enjoy books by Delilah Devlin but her stories aren't usually the kind that touch on all of my emotions like this one did. She made me cry and I think that's a good thing when I'm reading a romance.

This review is for Kat Cantrell's *Commanding Her SEAL*, for which an ARC was provided by the author and for *The Trouble with SEALs* by Anne Marsh from the personally purchased anthology.

If you have read any of the authors *ASSIGNMENT: Caribbean Nights* books, you will know who Charlie St. Croix is, and this novella gives you the information behind his decision to leave the SEALs, and start up *Aqueous Adventures*, with a few of his SEAL brothers. This prequel novella takes place roughly a year before the first full length novel from Kat's titles in the series.

"I'm on leave, and in two weeks, I'm going to disappear into my job again. There's not much room in my life for a woman who needs a man underfoot..."

The thing is Audra Reed, doesn't need a man underfoot, on vacation herself, she's only looking for a few weeks of no-strings, scorching hot sex, and that's exactly what she gets with Charlie.

"If you think I am the kind of guy who likes a woman to talk dirty to him... You're absolutely right."

But over those two weeks, sex deepens into something else for both of them, and all of a sudden saying goodbye without talking about a possibility of a future seems oh, so wrong.

"I want your hands on me."

This is a quick read, but the author packed a lot into it, now knowing why Charlie chose to take the life path he did and his reasoning's for it, makes me all the more eager for his book; *Redeeming Her SEAL*. After finishing this little interlude into his and Audra's first meeting and subsequent weeks together, I cannot wait to see what type of reconnection and romance the author gives them.

She becomes a part of this convoy and now Tavon and his SEAL team is hell-bent on rescuing her. Will they make it before any more deaths?
