Like any other Jack Greene book, Corruption is a wonderful amalgam of humor, sexiness and romance. Oh and erotic... heaven knows you can't ignore the eroticism. Honestly, I've already read this book three times and I seriously cannot get enough.

I first read this one in March of 2011, but decided to do a quick reread.

Tom is out with friends and as luck would have it, they end up somewhere they hadn't actually planned on, and Tom's initial annoyance changes when he sees a vision dancing so erotically and Tom is instantly taken with this dancer.
