Dark Night is book two in Caris Roane's Amulet Series. In this series, Caris tips her hat to erotica and I promise, sex plays a huge part. It's important to understand that it is used as part of the story not gratuitously but it's still used, a lot.

Dark Night is a bit longer than Wicked Night and tells us a bit more about the Amulets and how they were created and how they can be used. It's also longer so there is room for more story telling.

Master Vampire Eligio is pretty much on the prowl and rather horny. You would think any female would do but nope, he wants the witch Sol-Brenna but she's been keeping him at arm's length. But she just purchased an amulet on the black market and that's a big no-no. Eligio is willing to trade justice for sex all he has to do is get her to agree.
