Jamie just pissed me off. I really expected better of her. She was way too whiny.

Ryan was okay. He is more understanding, compassionate, and patient than Jamie could ever hope to be. He basically carried Jamie through the whole novel. I wish he stood up for himself a bit more. I wish he forced Jamie to see his side of things, and took her out of her self-involved world of pity. If there was such a thing *too* perfect, it's Ryan. A kind of hate saying this, but he was so perfect, it was almost boring.

The parts I *did* like about the book starts with the other super-people. They were super cool; the powers, their attitude, *Tyson*. I loved them. It was very X-Men, except for their ability to come up with superhero names. I mean, really? *Superbabe*? Disappointing.
