Saving him from the path of destruction and self loathing he started walking along after the death of his beloved sister they are his new family. Left bitter by his past relationship with his parents he feels he is not worthy to be loved.

Charline, bbf to Ayden who we met in book one, has since the moment she set eyes on Aleck had an incurable crush. Being younger and less experienced she always felt he didn't see her as a woman, never noticed her more than an annoyance or tag along. Throughout their shared history Aleck has always cast her aside refusing to take things further, always putting her in the friend zone. Little does she know he's protecting her from himself as he feels unworthy and incapable of love.

Although set in an MC with sub plots that involve the bikers, opposing factions and a blood vendetta...there is no lack of drama, suspense and intrigue the main focus of this story is love, friendship and acceptance. Their blossoming love is beautifully written as they struggle to resist the pull between them. Struggle to cope with rejection and their own insecurities to face one another with the truth.

First and foremost let me get this out of the way. Teaching Aleck, by Muriel Garcia, is a second book in a series and I felt that it would be most helpful to readers if they read the series in order. So, the first in the series is Saving Ayden. I just think that there were parts of Teaching Aleck, that if read as a standalone, would make the story seem choppy. Ok, enough from me.

After reading book 1 in the series Saving Ayden I was really looking forward to Aleck's story. We know from this first book that something was brewing between Charline and Aleck but Aleck was holding back...now we get to know why.

Aleck's past hasn't been easy. Growing up in a loveless family, with the only good thing he had ripped away from him, now he avoids commitment and anything that could bring him pain having never experienced love for himself. When Ayden brings home her best friend Charline Aleck thinks he's seen an angel, but she's only 17 and completely off limits.
